


Turning a Pioneer Cow Elk Call

Supplies Needed

- 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" x 3" Blank
- Cow Elk Call
- 5/8" WoodMaster Mandrel
- 41/64" Drill Bit
- Glue (Thick CA or Epoxy)
- Sandpaper/Finish
- Drill or Drill Press
- Eye and Ear Protection


Wood Preparation

- **1.** Select a blank 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" x 3".
- 2. Cut the blank to the size listed below.
- **3.** Mark and drill the blank as shown below. 41/64" diameter hole for the barrel.



Turning the Barrel

- Mount the 5/8" WoodMaster mandrel into a drill chuck or collet chuck.
- **2.** Slide the blank onto the mandrel and tighten the expansion screw so the blank will not slip while turning.
- **3.** Turn the blank to the desired shape. Note: make a 3/16" wide groove for the lanyard if so desired.
- **4.** Sand and finish all exposed surfaces of the barrel. Finish with a durable waterproof finish.



Assembly

- **1.** Place the reed between the reed holders with the corners of the reed against corner. (See Diagram Below.)
- 2. Press the reed assembly into the barrel until snug.
