

Turning a Finish Jar Kit

Supplies Needed


- 1/8" Drill Bit
- 1" x 6" Blank
- Screwdriver
- Glue (Thick CA or Epoxy)
- Sandpaper/Finish
- Eye and Ear Protection

Turning and Assembly

1. Turn the brush handle blank to your desired shape. Part one end off square to fit up against the jar lid.




- **2.** Mark the center point on the end of the brush and handle.
- **3.** Drill a 1/8" diameter hole about 3/4" deep where the pieces were marked.



- **4.** Drive the screw about half way into the handle piece.
- **5.** Grind the head of the screw off, leaving the end pointed and tapered.



- **6.** Find the center of the lid and drill an 1/8" hold through the lid.
- **7.** Put the handle over the hole and push the screw through the hole.
- **8.** Screw the bristle end of the brush onto the screw, and tighten securely.



9. The assembly will look best if the two parts line up, giving the appearance of a complete brush sticking through the lid.
