

# Pinecone and Shredded Cash Blanks

## Suggestions For Success

---

1. Thank you for purchasing our Mini-Pinecone or Shredded Cash Pen Blanks! Each blank was cast in a high-pressure chamber to reduce the occurrence air bubbles within each blank. However, you may find an occasional void, (the process is not perfect) which is easily remedied by using a drop or two of gap filling CA glue in the void. Let it dry (or use accelerator), as you work you way down to your final profile. Proceed with your final finishing procedure.
2. Be sure to back-paint the drill hole to ensure the best colors. For the Pinecone blanks, white works best if you want bright, vivid colors. Use a darker color if you want the colors to be darker. For the Shredded Cash Blank, it's best to use a shade of green to help camouflage the brass tube. A Q-tip dipped in the appropriate paint works very well to help spread the paint evenly in the drill hole.
